2. Pacific shall cause insulation and weatherization materials to be installed in Homeowners' home as follows:

C Eiling insulation. R-19 to L-38 value - 112853 ft.

The cost of the installation described above, for which Homeowners will ultimately be responsible under this agreement, is \$ 125.50

3. LIMITED WARRANTY PROVISION

Pacific shall contract with an independent insulation and weatherization contractor and will pay for work done as described above. Pacific snail contract with an independent insulation and weatherization contractor and will pay for work done as described above.

If upon completion of installation, Homeowners believe the work is deficient, Homeowners must contact the Manager, Weatherization Services Department, Pacific Power & Light Company, Public Building, 920 S.W. Sixth Avenue, Portland, Oregon 97204, (503) 243-1122, or the EXCEPT FOR THE WARRANTIES EXPRESSLY DESCRIBED IN THIS AGREEMENT, PACIFIC MAKES NO OTHER WARRANTIES. ALL EXPRESS AND IMPLIED WARRANTIES ARE EXTENDED ONLY TO AND LIMITED TO THE HOMEOWNERS, WILL START UPON COMPLETION OF THE INSTALLATION OF THE INSULATION, AND WILL TERMINATE OR IMPLIED WARRANTIES, NEGLIGENCE, STRICT LIABILITY OR CONTRACT ARE LIMITED TO THOSE REMEDIES FOR ANY CLAIM, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO EXPRESS PRESSLY DESCRIBED HEREIN, AND IN NO EVENT SHALL PACIFIC BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES TO HOMEOWNERS OR ANYONE ELSE.

Pacific may petition the appropriate Oregon Legislature to amend current law to allow the Company, rather than individual owner-occupants, to receive the benefit of any tax credit accruing from the installation of energy saving materials provided for herein.

4. HOMEOWNERS' OBLIGATION TO REPAY

Homeowners may pay such cost to Pacific at any time prior to the time payment is due.

5. HOMEOWNERS' OBLIGATION TO NOTIFY

Homeowners shall notify Pacific in writing of the sale or transfer of any legal or equitable interest in any part of the property, whether it is Homeowners snail notify racine in writing of the sale or transfer of any legal or equitable interest in any part of the property, whether it is before the exepcted sale or transfer, and not tare than one week before the exepcted sale or transfer.
