E) and Light 6 7 A Hearing was held in this matter at Klamath Falls, 8 Oregon, on July 9, 1979, pursuant to notice given in conformity 9 with Ordinance No. 35, Klamath County, before the Klamath County 10 Hearings Officer, Jim Spindor. The applicant was represented by 11 H. F. Smith, The Klamath County Planning Department was represent 12 ed by Carl Shuck. The Hearings Reporter was Barbara Thomson. 13 Evidence was presented on behalf of the Department and 14 on behalf of the applicant. There were two people present who 15 were in opposition to the Conditional Use Permit requested by the 16 17 applicant. The following exhibits were offered, received and made 18 19 a part of the record: Klamath County Exhibit A, the Staff Report $\mathbf{20}$ Klamath County Exhibit B, legal 21 Klamath County Exhibit C, Assessor's Maps 22 Klamath County Exhibit D, Applicant's Maps $\mathbf{23}$ The Hearing was then closed, and based upon the evi-24 dence submitted at the hearing, the Hearings Officer made the 25following Findings of Fact: 26 FINDINGS OF FACT: 27 Under ORS 469.400(5), Klamath County has no choice 281

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but to grant this Conditional Use Permit. Klamath County has 2 jurisdiction to issue said permit under ORS 469.400(5), which gives Counties permission to exercise enforcement authority over 3 4 such permits.

The granting of this Conditional Use Permit is 2. conditioned upon the applicant complying with all those conditions 6 set forth in the Site Certificate which has been issued with 7 regard to the placement of the power line. The granting of this 8 Conditional Use Permit is further conditioned on the applicant 9 delivering a certified copy of said Site Certificate to the 10 Klamath County Planning Department within fifteen (15) days from 11 12 the date of this Order.

The Hearings Officer, based on the foregoing Findings of Fact, accordingly orders as follows:

That real property described as the

Beginning in Section 20, Township 41, Range 13, and continuing through Sections 20, 17, 8, 7 and 6 of said township and range; thence running through Section 1 of Township 41, Range 12; continuing through Sections 36, 35, 26, 27, 28, 29 and 30 of Township 40, Range 12, proceeding through Sections 24, 23, 22, 21, 28, 29 and 30 of Township 40, Range 11; and through Sections 25 and 26 of Township 40, Range 10, terminating at a point just past the north-south centerline of Section 26 of said Township and Range, with first application for Conditional Use Permit being from the Jackson
