In the event that any portion or all of said property shall be taken under the right of entinent domain or condemnation, beneficiary shall have the right, if it so elects, to require that all or any portion of the monies payable as compensation for such taking, which are in excess of the amount required to pay all reasonable costs, expenses and attorney's fees necessarily paid or incurred by grantor in such proceedings, shall be paid to beneficiary and applied by it first upon any reasonable costs and expenses and attorney's fees, both in the trial and appellate courts, necessarily paid or incurred by beneficiary in such proceedings, and the balance applied upon the indebteduces secured hereby; and grantor agrees, at its own expense, to take such actions and execute such instruments as shall be necessary in obtaining such compensation, promptly upon beneficiary's request.

9. At any time and from time to time upon written request of beneficiary, payment of, its fees and presentation of this deed and the note for endorsement (in case of full reconveyances, for cancellation), without affecting the liability of any person for the payment of the indebtedness, trusten may

(a) consent to the making of any map or plat of said property; (b) join in granting any easement or creating any restriction thereon; (c) join in any subordination or other agreement allecting this deed of the lien or charge thereof; (d) reconvey, without warranty, all or any, part of the property. The grantee in any reconveyance may be described as the 'person or persons legally entitled thereof,' and the recitals there not any matters or lacts shall be conclusive proof of the truthfulness thereof. Trustee's lees for any of the services mentioned in this parastraph shall be not less than \$5.

10. Upon any default by grantor hereunder, heneliciary may at any time without notice, either in person, by agent or by a receiver to be appointed by a court, and without regard to the adequacy of any security for the indebtedness hereby secured, enter upon and take possession of said property or any part thereof, in its own name sue or otherwise collect the rents, issues and profits, including those past due and unpaid, and apply the stone, less costs and expenses of operation and collection, including trasonable attorney's less upon any indebtedness secured hereby, and in such order as beneficiary may determine.

In the latter event the beneliciary or the truster/shall execute and cause to be recorded his written notice of default and his/election to sell the said described real property to satisfy the obligations secured hereby, where upon the trustee shall lix the time and place of saie, give notice thereof as then required by law and proceed to loceclose this trust deed in the manner provided in ORS 86.740 to 86.795.

13.
