FINDINGS OF FACT AND ORDER

FINDINGS OF FACT:

1. The site is adequate in size and shape to house 3 the proposed activity, and it does fit in with the neighborhood as is shown by the fact that there are other mobile homes in the 5 area, and also by the fact that this will be a temporary placement.

- 2. The site has adequate access to the streets and highways to carry the traffic flow generated by the proposed use.
- 3. There would be no adverse effects on abutting property owners.
- 4. No one testified in opposition to the Conditional Use Permit.
- 5. The granting of the Conditional Use Permit is consistent with the goals of the L.C.D.C.
- 6. This Conditional Use Permit is approved subject to the following conditions:

CONDITIONS:

- 1. Applicant follows plot plan, Applicant's Exhibit 19 No. 1.
 - 2. Placement of mobile home will be allowed for a maximum of three years.

The Hearings Officer, based on the foregoing Findings of Fact, accordingly orders as follows:
