This trust deed shall further secure the payment of such additional money, if any, as may be loaned hereafter by the beneficiary to the grantor or others having an interest in the above described property, as may be evidenced by a note or notes. If the indebtedness secured by this trust deed is evidenced by more than one note, the beneficiary may credit payments received by it upon any of said notes or part of any payment on one note and part on another, as the beneficiary may elect.

The grantor hereby covenants to and with the trustee and the beneficiary berein that the said premises and property conveyed by this trust deed are free and clear of all encumbrances and that the grantor will and his heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend his said title thereto against the claims of all persons whomsoever.

The grantor covenants and agrees to pay said note according to the terms thereof and, when due, all taxes, assessments and other charges levied against and property; to keep said property free from all encumbrances having precedence over this trust deed; to complete all buildings in course of construction or hereafter constructed on said premises within six months from the date hereof or the date construction is hereafter commenced; to repair and restore promptly and in good workmanlike manner any building or improvement on said property which may be damaged or destroyed and pay, when due, all times during construction; to replace any work or materials unsatisfactory to beneficiary within fifteen days after written notice from beneficiary of such fact; not to remove or destroy any building or improvements now or horeafter enceted upon said property in good repair and to commit or suffer no waste of said premises; to keep all buildings, property and improvements now or hereafter erected on said property in good repair and to commit or suffer no waste of said premises; to keep all buildings, property and improvements now or hereafter erected on said premises continuously insured against loss by fire or such other hazards as the beneficiary may from time to time require, in a sum not less than the original principal sum of the note or obligation secured by this trust deed, in a company or companies acceptable to the beneficiary, and to deliver the original policy of insurance in correct form and with premium paid, to the principal place of business of the beneficiary at least fifteen days prior to the effective date of any such policy of insurance. If said policy of insurance is not so tendered, the beneficiary will insurance shall be non-cancellable by the grantor during the full term of the policy thus

That for the purpose of proteing regularly for the prompt payment of all taxes, assessments, and governmental charges levied or assessed against the above described property and insurance prendum while the indebtedness secured hereby is in excess of 80% of the lesser of the original purchase price paid by the grantor at the time the loan was made or the beneficiary's original appraisal value of the property at the time the loan was made, grantor will pay to the beneficiary in addition to the monthly payments of principal and interest appable under the terms of the note or obligation secured hereby on the date installments on principal and interest are payable an amount equal to 1/12 of the taxes, assessments, and other charges due and payable with respect to sald property within each succeeding three years while this Trust Deed is in effect as estimated and directed by the beneficiary. Hereficiary shall pay to the grantor literest on sald amounts at a rate not less than the highest rate authorized to be paid by banks on their open passbook accounts minus 3/1 of 1%. If such rate is less than 4%, the rate of interest paid shall be 4% interest shall be computed on the akeroge monthly balance in the account and shall be paid quarterly to the grantor by crediting to the escrow account the amount of the interest due.

While the grantor is to pay any and all taxes, assessments and other charges levied or assessed against said property, or any part thereof, before the same begin to bear interest, and also to pay premiums on all insurance policies upon said property, such payments are to be made through the beneficiary, as aforesaid. The grantor hereby, authorizes the beneficiary to pay any and all taxes, assessments and other charges levied or imposed sgainst said property in the amounts as shown by the statements thereof furnished by the collector of such taxes, assessments or other charges, and to pay the insurance premiums in the amounts shown on the statements submitted by the insurance carriers or their representatives and to withdraw the sums which may be required from the reserve account if any, established for that purpose. The grantor agrees in no event to bold the beneficiary responsible for failure to have any insurance written or for any loss or damage growing out of a defect in any insurance policy, and the beneficiary hereby is authorized, in the event of any loss, to compromise and settle with any insurance company and to apply any such insurance receipts upon the obligations occurred by this trust deed. In computing the amount of the indebtedness for payment and satisfaction in full or upon sale or other

acquisition of the property by the beneficiary after default, any balance remaining in the reserve account shall be credited to the indebtedness. If any authorized reserve account for taxes, assessments, insurance premiums and other charges is not sufficient at any time_for the payment of such charges as they become due, the grantor shall pay the deficit to the beneficiary upon demand, and if not paid within ten days after such demand, the beneficiary may at its option add the amount of such deficit to the principal of the obligation secured hereby.

Should the grantor fail to keep any of the foregoing covenants, therebeneficiary may at its option carry out the same, and all its expenditures it for shall draw interest at the rate specified in the note, shall be repayable the grantor on demand and shall be secured by the lien of this trust deep this connection, the beneficiary shall have the right in its discretion to come any improvements made on said premises and also to make such repairs to property as in its sole discretion it may deem necessary or advisable.

The grantor further agrees to comply with all laws, ordinances, regulations, covenants, conditions and restrictions affecting said property; to pay all costs, fees and expenses of this trust, including the cost of title search, as well as the other costs and expenses of the trustee incurred in connection with or in enforcing this obligation, and trustee's and attorney's fees actually incurred; to appear in and defend any action or proceeding purporting to affect the security hereof, or the rights or powers of the beneficiary or trustee; and to pay all costs and expenses, including cost of evidence of title and attorney's fees in a reasonable sum to be fixed by the court, in any such action or proceeding in which the beneficiary or trustee may appear and in any suit brought by beneficiary to foreclose this deed, and all said sums shall be secured by this trust deed.

The heneficiary will furnish to the grantor on written request therefor an number of account but shall not be obligated or required to furnish y further statements of account.

It is mutually agreed that:

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 1. In the event that any portion or all of said property shall be taken under the right of eminent domain or condemnation, the beneficiary shall have the right to commence, prosecute in its own name, appear in or defend any action or proceedings, or to make any compromise or settlement in connection with such taking and, if it so elects, to require that all or any portion of the money's payable as compensation for such taking, which are in excess of the amount required to pay all reasonable costs, expenses and attorney's fees necessarily padd or incurred by the grantor in such proceedings, shall be paid to the beneficiary and applied upon the indebtedness secured hereby; and the grantor agree, at its own expense, to take such actions and execute such instruments as shall be necessary in obtaining such compensation, promptly upon the beneficiary's request.
- 2. At any time and from time to time upon written request of the bene-ficiary, payment of its fees and presentation of this deed and the note for en-dorsement (in case of full reconveyance, for cancellation), without affecting the liability of any person for the payment of the indebtedness, the trustee may (a), consent to the making of any map or plat of said property; (b) join in grantian any casement or creating and restriction thereon, (c) join in any subordination or other agreement affecting this deed or the lien or charge hereof; (d) reconvey, without warranty, all or any part of the property. The grantee in any reconvey-ance may be described as the "person or persons legally entitled thereto" and the recitals therein of any matters or facts shall be conclusive proof of the truthfulness thereof. Trustee's fees for any of the services in this paragraph shall be \$5.00.

As additional security, grantor hereby assigns to beneficiary during the continuance of these trusts all rents, issues, royalties and profits of the property affected by this deed and of any personal property located thereon. Until grantor shall default in the payment of any indebtedness accured hereby or in the performance of any agreement hereunder, grantor shall have the thirst to collect all such rents, issues, royalties and profits earned prior to default as they become due and payable. Upon any default by the grantor hereunder, the beneficiary may at any time without notice, either in person, by agent or by a receiver to be appointed by a court, and without regard to the adequacy of an security for the indebtedness hereby secured, enter upon and take possession of said property, or any part thereof, in its own name sue for otherwise collect the rents, issues and profits, including those past due and ungaid, and apply the same, less costs and expenses of operation and collection; including reasonable attorney's fees, upon any indebtedness secured hereby, and in such order as the beneficiary may determine.
