KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That JAMES V. HAAPOJA and LOIS J. HAAPOJA, husband and wife, hereinafter called the grantor, for the consideration hereinafter stated, to grantor paid by J. D. WEN, hereinafter called an Oregon corporation, the grantee, does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said grantee and grantee's heirs, successors and assigns, that certain real property, with the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or appertaining, situated in the County of Klamath and State of Oregon, described as follows, to-wit:

PARCEL 1: WSW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 1, NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 2, NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 12, all in Township 40 S., R. 13 E.W.M., SAVING AND EXCEPTING THEREFROM those portions conveyed to the United States of America by Deed Volume 64, Page 298, Deed Volume 69, Page 292, Deed Volume 69, Page 556, and Deed Volume 75, Page 552.

PARCEL 2: SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 2, ENE $\frac{1}{4}$, SWNE $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 11, all in Township 40 S., R. 13 E.W.M., containing 320 acres, more or less, SAVING AND EXCEPTING THEREFROM a strip of land aggregating 1.2 acres in area in the said SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and SWNE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 11, described by metes and bounds, heretofore conveyed to the United States by deed dated February 10, 1926, recorded May 29, 1926, in Volume 69, Page 606, Deed Records of Klamath County, Oregon.

SUBJECT TO: (1) Liability for deferred taxes under farm use statute, (CONTINUED ON REVERSE)

To Have and to Hold the same unto the said grantee and grantee's heirs, successors and assigns forever. And said grantor hereby covenants to and with said grantee and grantee's heirs, successors and assigns, that grantor is lawfully seized in fee simple of the above granted premises, free from all encumbrances, except as herein stated,

and that grantor will warrant and forever defend the said premises and every part and parcel thereof against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whomsoever, except those claiming under the above described encumbrances.

The true and actual consideration paid for this transfer, stated in terms of dollars, is \$530,000.00. However, the actual consideration consists of ~~other property or value given or promised which is the whole or part of the consideration indicated which~~ (The sentence between the symbols Δ , if not applicable, should be deleted. In construing this deed and where the context so requires, the singular includes the plural and all grammatical changes shall be implied to make the provisions hereof apply equally to corporations and to individuals.
