RESOLUTION

6 WHEREAS, Article 61, Section 61.002 of Klamath County
7 Zoning Ordinance No. 17, gives the Board of County Commissioners
8 the authority to allow by Resolution uses the Board may deem to
9 be similar to the uses permitted in the CP (Commercial Administra-
10 tive Professional) zone and not obnoxious or detrimental to the
11 public health, safety, and welfare; and

12 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has reviewed
13 the uses allowed in the CP (Commercial Administrative Profession-
14 al) zone and has determined that the use mentioned in the above
15 heading is similar to the uses allowed in the CP (Commercial
16 Administrative Professional) zone, such uses including administra-
17 tive and professional offices, and biological and medical labora-
18 tories; therefore,

19 BE IT RESOLVED that a veterinary clinic will hereby be
20 allowed in the CP (Commercial Administrative Professional) zone
21 provided that all functions of the clinic be carried out indoors
22 and that a Conditional Use Permit shall be applied for under the
23 provisions of Klamath County Zoning Ordinance No. 17.
