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THIS MATTER having come before the Board of County Commissioners of Klamath County, Oregon, the 31st day of October, 1979, on the petition of Benny A. Critelli and Ann F. Critelli, husband and wife, for a statutory way of necessity, Dryden and Edna McIntosh, husband and wife, respondents, and the following persons being present:

> Floyd Wynne, Chairman of the Board Alvin Cheyne, County Commissioner Nell Kuonen, County Commissioner Francis Roberts, County Engineer Robert Boivin, County Counsel Neil D. Smith, Counsel for petitioners,

And, no one appearing to represent Mr. and Mrs. McIntosh, the respondents, after adequate notice having been duly given the Commissioners held a hearing on the matter; examined exhibits and weighed the report of the Board of Road Viewers as filed September 20, 1970; Commissioner Cheyne made a motion to omit that portion of the road viewers report which required that the Critellis furnish a survey, description and map of the way of necessity for the reason that in this particular case the way of necessity connects with private easements which easements can be moved at anytime by the grantors. ORDER - 1

The motion was unanimously accepted. A motion was then made by Chairman Floyd Wynne, seconded by Commissioner Kuonen to grant the way of necessity to petitioners in as much as the evidence and discussion showed that such was warranted and that there was no opposition to the granting of the way of necessity.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the petition of Benny A. and Ann F. Critelli for a statutory way of necessity shall be unconditionally granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the way of necessity shall be described as follows:

A thirty foot wide existing road which is recorded as an easement to Eugene P. and Joanne M. Corvell recorded at Volume M74, page 7514 and an easement to Michael R. and Peggy L. Peterson, as recorded in Volume M79 at page 6839. The easement is further described as beginning on the northern terminus of the easement across James H. and Lois Woods land on the south running in a northwesterly direction and joining the easement across the Critellis' land on the north across the land of Dryden and Edna Gayle McIntosh
