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Klamath County Planning FINDINGS OF FACT AND ORDER

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In the Matter of Request for Conditional Use Permit No. 79-30) for David McMinn, Applicant

A hearing was held in this matter at Klamath Falls, Oregon, on October 10, 1979, pursuant to notice given in conformity with Ordinance No. 35, Klamath County, before the Klamath County Hearings Officer, Jim Spindor. The applicant was present. The Klamath County Planning Department was represented by Jonathan Chudnoff. The Hearings Reporter was Barbara Thomson.

Evidence was presented on behalf of the Department and on behalf of the applicant. There were fourteen (14) adjacent property owners in opposition present who stated they had objections to the proposed Cc iditional Use Permit requested by the applicant. There were two (2) adjacent property owners present who stated they were in favor of the proposed Conditional Use Permit requested by the applicant.

The hearing was then closed, and based upon the evidence submitted at the hearing, the Hearings Officer made the following Findings of Fact:

FINDINGS OF FACT:

- 1. The site is not adequate in size and shape to house the proposed activity, and does not fit in with the general neighborhood.
- 2. Testimony was given in opposition to the granting of this Conditional Use Permit by persons living in the immediate neighborhood.
- 3. The granting of this permit would have an adverse effect on abutting and nearby property owners, due to the smell which would be caused by this use.

The Hearings Officer, based on the foregoing Findings of Fact, accordingly orders as follows:

That real property described as the

"parcel of land approximately one acre in size generally located east of Altamont Drive and approximately 350 feet north of Bristol Avenue, in the South Suburban Area, and more particularly described as Lot 6 of the Second Addition to Altamont Acres, Township 39, Range 9, Section 10, being Tax Lots 4500 and 4600, Klamath County, Oregon"

is hereby denied a Conditional Use Permit in accordance with the terms of the Klamath County Zoning Ordinance No. 35, and, henceforth, will not be allowed to keep pigs in the RA
