The site has adequate access to streets and highways Δ to carry the traffic flow which will be generated by the proposed 5 6 use. 7 3. There will be no adverse effect on abutting property owners as long as the conditions set hereinbelow are followed. 8 9 4. No one testified in opposition to the Conditional 10 Use Permit. 11 5.
