All in Township 39 South, Range 11 East of the Willamette Meridian Section 15: WinE4, SE4, SINW4, All that portion of the NinWk lying South of Lost River, and the N2SW4, SAVING AND EXCEPTING the following: Beginning at a 1/2 inch iron pin from which the Northwest corner of said Section 15 bears North 01°44'03" West 3681.45 feet; thence South 78°02'07" East 174.45 feet to a ½ inch iron pin; thence South 89°52'45" East 231.30 feet to a ½ inch iron pin; thence South 89°20'52" East 801.00 feet to a ½ inch iron pin; thence South 15°16'07" East 217.00 feet to a 4 inch iron pin; thence continuing South 15°16'07" East 20 feet, more or less, to the South line of the N2SW4 of said Section 15; thence Westerly along said line to the Southwest corner

of the NW4SW4 of said Section 15; thence Northerly along the West line of said Section 15 to a point that bears South 81°00'05" West from the point of beginning; thence North 81°00'05" East to a 2 inch iron pin set in an existing north-south fence line; thence continuing North 81°00'05" East 76.21 feet to the point of beginning, containing 7.2 acres, more or less,

with bearings based on Bowne Addition to the Town of Bonanza.

Beginning at the intersection of the West right of way line of West Park Street in vacated East Bonanza, with the line between Sections 10 and 15, Township 39 South, Range 11 East of the Willamette Meridian, which point is 1910 feet West of the corner common to Sections 10, 11, 14 and 15 of said Township and Range; thence North along the West line of said West Park Street to the Southerly right of way line of Klamath County Market Road No. 5; thence Northwesterly along said right of way line to the point of intersection with the West bank of Lost River near the West end of the Market Road Bridge; thence Southerly along the West bank of the East Channel of lost River to its intersection with the North line of the vacated $\mathsf{S}^{\mathsf{L}_2}$ of Block 55; thence East to the East line of said Block 55; thence South to the South line of said Block 55; thence West to the West line of said Block 55; thence South 150 feet, more or less, to the South boundary line of said Section 10; thence East along said Section line 660 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning.

EXCEPTING from the last described parcel that portion thereof described as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the centerline of West Park Street in vacated East Bonanza, with the Southerly right of way line of the existing Langell Valley Market Road; thence Northwesterly along the Southerly line of the existing Langell Valley Market Road to the West bank of Lost River near the West end of the Market Road Bridge; thence Southerly along the West bank of the East Channel of Lost River to a point 300 feet Southerly of (when measured at right angles to) the relocated centerline of Langell Valley Market Road; thence Easterly parallel to said relocated centerline 30 feet, more or less, to a point opposite centerline station 9+15 on said relocated centerline; thence Northerly at right angles to said relocated centerline 250 feet; thence Easterly parallel to and 50 feet Southerly of said relocated centerline 485 feet, more or less, to the centerline of said West Park Street; thence North along the centerline of said West Park Street 45 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning. The relocated centerline referred to above is described Beginning at Engineer's centerline Station 4+71, said Station as follows: being 1269 feet North and 2428 feet East of the Southwest corner of said Section 10; thence North 89°50'30" East 374.83 feet; thence on a 2291.83 foot radius curve right (the long chord of which bears South 79°07' East) 883.33 feet to Station 17+29.16.

Together with two 1973 Concord mobile homes, serial numbers 4313 and 4614, and any replacement thereof, which is declared to be appurtenant thereto.

Together with a $7\frac{1}{2}$ HP Westinghouse electric motor, serial #OEMM6884, with a Pacific centrifugal pump, serial #5P8706, and a 60 HP Marathon electric motor with a Berkeley centrifugal pump, serial #EB 92390 - 2/16, and a 60 HP G.E. electric motor with a Cornell centrifugal pump, serial #12724, and any replacements thereof; all of which are hereby declared to be appurtenant thereto.

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including all leases, permits, licenses or privileges, written or otherwise, appurtenant or nonappurtenant to said mortgaged premises, now held by mortgagors or hereafter issued, extended or renewed to them by the United States or the State or any department, bureau, or agency thereof, which have been or will be assigned or waived to mortgagee.

Together with the tenements, hereditaments, rights, privileges and appurtenances, including private roads, now or hereafter belonging to or used in connection with the above described premises; and all plumbing, lighting, heating, cooling, ventilating, elevating, watering and irrigating apparatus and other fixtures, now or hereafter belonging to or used in connection with the above described premises, all of which are hereby declared to be appurtenant to said land; and together with all waters and water rights of every kind and description and however evidenced, and all ditches or other conduits, rights therein and rights of way therefor, which now are or hereafter may be appurtenant to said premises or any part thereof, or used in connection therewith.

This conveyance is intended as a mortgage securing the performance of the covenants and agreements hereinafter contained, and the payment of the debt represented by one promissory note made by the mortgagors to the order of the mortgagee, of even date herewith, for the principal sum of \$318,000.00, with interest as provided for in said note, being payable in installments, the last of which being due and payable on the first day of January, 2015.

MORTGAGORS COVENANT AND AGREE:

That they are lawfully seized of said premises in fee simple, have good right and lawful authority to convey and mortgage the same, and that said premises are free from encumbrance; and each of the mortgagors will warrant and defend the same forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whomsoever, and this covenant shall not be extinguished by any foreclosure hereof, but shall run with the land.

To pay all debts and money secured hereby when due.

To keep the buildings and other improvements now or hereafter existing on said premises in good repair; to complete without delay the construction on said premises of any building, structure or improvement in progress, any improvements to existing structures in progress, and any improvements or remodeling for which the loan hereby secured was granted in whole or in part; not to remove or demolish or permit the removal or demolishment of any building thereon; to restore promptly in a good and workmanlike manner any building, structure or improvement thereon which may be damaged or destroyed; to comply with all laws, ordinances, regulations, covenants, conditions and restrictions affecting the property and its use; not to use or permit the use of said premises for any unlawful or objectionable purpose; not to cut or permit the cutting of timber from said premises except for domestic use; to maintain and cultivate the premises in good and husbandlike manner, using approved methods of preserving the fertility thereof; to keep the orchards on said lands properly irrigated, cultivated, sprayed, pruned and cared for; not to commit or suffer waste of any kind upon said premises; and to do all acts or things necessary to preserve all water rights now or hereafter appurtenant to or used in connection with said premises.

To pay before delinquency all taxes, assessments and other charges upon said premises, all assessments upon water company stock, and all rents, assessments and charges for water appurtenant to or used in connection with said property; and to suffer no other encumbrance, charge or lien against said premises which is superior to this mortgage.

To keep all buildings now existing or hereafter erected continuously insured against loss or damage by fire and such other risks in manner and form and in such company or companies and in such amounts as shall be satisfactory to the mortgagee; to pay all premiums and charges on all such insurance when due; to deposit with the mortgagee upon request all insurance policies affecting the premises, with receipts showing payment of all premiums and charges affecting said policies; and that all insurance whatsoever affecting the premises shall be made payable, in case of loss, to the mortgagee, with a loss payable clause in favor of and satisfactory to the mortgagee. The mortgagee shall be entitled to receive the proceeds of any loss under any such policy which may be applied by the mortgagee upon the indebtedness hereby secured in such manner as it may elect.

If any of the mortgaged property shall be taken under right of eminent domain, the mortgagee shall be entitled at its option to receive all compensation for the portion taken and damages to the remaining portion, to be applied by the mortgagee upon the indebtedness hereby secured in such manner as it shall elect.

Should the mortgagors be or become in default in any of the covenants or agreements herein contained, then the mortgagee (whether electing to declare the whole indebtedness hereby secured due and payable or not) may, at its option, perform the same in whole or in part and all expenditures made by the mortgagee in so doing, together with interest and costs, shall be immediately repayable by the mortgagors without demand, shall be secured by this mortgage, and shall draw interest until paid at the default rates provided for in the note hereby secured.

Time is material and of the essence hereof; and in case of breach of any of the covenants or agreements hereof, or if default be made in the payment of any of the sums hereby secured, or if the whole or any portion of said loan shall be expended for purposes other than those specified in the original application therefor except, by the written permission of said mortgagee, or if said land or any portion thereof shall be hereafter included in any special assessment district, then, in any such case, all indebtedness hereby secured, shall, at the election of the mortgagee, become immediately due without notice, and this mortgage may be foreclosed; but the failure of the mortgagee to exercise such option in any one or more instances shall not be considered as a waiver or relinquishment of the right to exercise such option upon or during the continuance of the same or any other default.

In case of any suit to foreclose this mortgage or to collect any charge growing out of the debt hereby secured, or any suit which the mortgagee may deem it necessary to prosecute or defend to effect or protect the lien hereof, the mortgagors agree to pay a reasonable sum as attorney's fees and all costs and legal expenses in connection with said suit, and further agree to pay the reasonable costs of searching records and abstracting or insuring the title, and such sums shall be secured hereby and included in the decree of foreclosure.

Upon or during the continuance of any default hereunder, the mortgagee shall have the right forthwith to enter into and upon the mortgaged premises and take possession thereof, and collect the rents, issues and profits thereof, and apply the same, less reasonable costs of collection, upon the indebtedness hereby secured, and the mortgagee shall have the right to the appointment of a receiver to collect the rents, issues and profits of the mortgaged premises. The rents, issues and profits of said premises after default are hereby assigned and mortgaged to the mortgagee as additional security for the indebtedness herein described.

This mortgage and the note secured hereby are executed and delivered under and in accordance with the Farm Credit Act of 1971 and any acts amendatory or supplementary thereto and the regulations of the Farm Credit Administration, and are subject to all the terms, conditions and provisions thereof, which are made a part hereof the same as if set out in full herein.

The covenants and agreements herein contained shall extend to and be binding upon the heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns of the respective parties hereto.
