ORDER

THIS MATTER having come on for hearing upon the application of Southern Oregon Broadcasting Company for a zone change from A (Agricultural) to AF (Agricultural Forestry), by the Klamath County Planning Commission, on real property described as Township 38, Range 9, Section 28. Public hearings having been heard by the Klamath County Planning Commission on October 9, 1979, wherefrom the testimony, reports, and information produced at the hearing by the applicant, members of the Planning Department Staff and other persons in attendance, the Planning Commission recommended approval to the Board of County Commissioners. Following action by the Planning Commission, a public hearing before the Board of County Commissioners was regularly held on November 29, 1979, wherefrom the testimony at said hearing it appeared that the record below was accurate and complete and it appeared from the testimony, reports and exhibits introduced at the hearing before the Planning Commission that the application for a zone change for the subject property, should be granted.

The Board of County Commissioners makes the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law as required by Ordinance No. 17, the Klamath County Zoning Ordinance:

FINDINGS OF FACT:

1. The Board of County Commissioners found site to be located in Township 38, Range 9, Section 28, and generally located

- The Board of County Commissioners found site for change in zone would continue in its same use, that being a microwave site. The use is allowed outright in the AF (Agricultural-Forestry) zone.
- 3. The Board of County Commissioners found site is not an agricultural unit, but the change in zone to AF (Agricultural Forestry) allows existing use.
- 4. The Board of County Commissioners found site for change in zone is a zone change only as the existing land use designation is agricultural.
- The Board of County Commissioners found notification 5. had been sent to the media as well as to those agencies of concern and also to the surrounding land owners, therefore addressing L. C. D. C. Goal No. 1.
- 6. The Board of County Commissioners found site has no trees of commercial value, therefore addressing L. C. D. C. Goal No. 4.
- The Board of County Commissioners found site for 7. change in zone was utilized as a site for a microwave tower and would continue to be used as such to serve as a public facility, therefore addressing L. C. D. C. Goal No. 11.
- 8. The Board of County Commissioners found site had the existing use of a microwave tower and use would continue as such and would not be moved, therefore conserving on energy by not having to move or relocate, therefore addressing L. C. D. C. Goal No. 13.

- 5. The proposed change of zone is in keeping with any land use plans duly adopted and does, in effect, represent the highest, best and most appropriate use of the land affected.
