Pacific warrants that the insulation and weatherization materials will be installed in a workmanlike manner consistent with prevailing industry Tracing warrants that the institution and weatherization materials will be installed in a workmanner consistent with prevaiing industry standards. If installation is not installed in a workmanlike manner, Pacific, at no expense to the Homeowners, will cause any deficiencies to be

4. HOMEOWNERS OBLIGATION TO REPAY

Individual Homeowners (natural persons) shall pay to Pacific, without interest, the actual contract cost of the insulation and weatherization prior to the sale or transfer for consideration of any legal or equitable interest in any part of the property. Homeowners other than natural persons prior to the sale or transfer for consideration of any legal or equitable interest in any part of the property. - 8. Each Homeowner who signs this agreement shall be individually and jointly responsible for performing the obligations of Homeowners in this agreement. This agreement shall be binding upon the successors and assigns of the parties. Homeowners shall not assign this agreement without the written consent of Pacific.
- 9. This document contains the entire agreement between the parties and shall not be modified except by a written instrument signed by the parties.

10. HOMEOWNERS RIGHT TO CANCEL (OREGON STATUTE)
