The Klamath County Board of Commissioners invites written sealed bids for One (1) Portable Jaw Crushing Plant for the Klamath County Department of Public Works. The following bill of particulars shall govern the bid: Specifications are on file in the County Clerk's Office and are open for inspection by the public between the hours of 8:30 A.M. and 5:00 P.M., Monday through Friday. Specifications may be procured from the County Purchasing Agent.

A certified check, cashiers check or surety bond in the amount of 5% of the total bid, made payable to the Clerk of the Klamath County Board of Commissioners must accompany the sealed bid.

Written sealed bids in envelopes clearly marked "PORTABLE JAW CRUSHING PLANT KLAMATH COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS" shall be delivered or mailed to the County Clerk's Office only. No bid will be considered if received later than 11:00 A.M., PST, February 5, 1980. The bids will be opened and read aloud in the Commissioners Hearing Room located in the Courthouse Annex.

No bid will be received or considered by the Board of Commissioners unless the bid contains a statement by the bidder, as a part of his bid, that the provisions required by subsection (4) of ORS 279.350 be included in his contract.

The bidder must clearly identify all products he proposes to furnish. When applicable, brand name and model or number shall be shown. Catalogs and other data should be furnished with the bid or be on file in the office of the buyer.

A faithful performance bond in the total amount of the bid will be required of the successful bidder.
