SECURITY INTEREST MARDORY HOITASIRBHITA, W 3415 To secure the Homeowners' obligations herein, Homeowners hereby mortgage to Pacific the property, together with all present and future appurtenances, improvements, and fixtures thereto. This paragraph shall not take effect until that date which is one day prior to the earliest to occur

- (1) the date on which any legal or equitable interest in any part of the property is transferred;
