Klamath County Planning FINDINGS OF FACT AND ORDER

A hearing was held in this matter at Klamath Falls, Oregon, on March 12, 1980, pursuant to notice given in conformity with Ordinance No. 35, Klamath County, before the Klamath County Hearings Officer, Jim Spindor. The applicant was present. Klamath County Planning Department was represented by Jonathan Chudnoff. The Hearings Reporter was Barbara Thomson.

The hearing was then closed, and based upon the evidence submitted at the hearing, the Hearings Officer made the following Findings of Fact:

## FINDINGS OF FACT:

- The site is adequate in size and shape to house the proposed activity and will fit in with the neighborhood so long as the condition imposed hereinbelow is followed.
- The site has adequate access to the streets and highways to carry the traffic flow generated by the proposed use.
- There would be no adverse effect on the abutting property owners, so long as the condition imposed hereinbelow is followed.
- No one testified in objection to the granting of the permit.
- The granting of this permit is consistent with the goals of the L. C. D. C.
- The issuance of this Conditional Use Permit is conditioned on the applicant not having any signs on his property to advertise or designate that he has a business on said property.

The Hearings Officer, based on the foregoing Findings of Fact, accordingly orders as follows:

That real property described as the

"parcel of land approximately one acre in size and generally located 1 3/4 miles east of Highway No. 97 and approximately 9 miles north of Gilchrist generally located south of Randy Road and approximately 863 feet west of Jerry Road, and more particularly described as Lot 3, Block 8, Antelope Meadows Third Addition, being in Section 16, Township 23, Range 10, Tax Lot 14,100; Klamath County, Oregon"
