- 2. Pacific shall cause insulation and weatherization materials checked below (subject to notations) to be installed in Homeowner's home pursuant to current Company Specifications, XI Storm Windows: Install 17 window(s) totalling approximately 294 sq. ft.
 XI Storm Doors: Install 3 doors.
 XI Weatherstrip 2 doors.
 Sliding Doors: Install doors.

 - Sliding Doors: Install _______doors.

 Ceiling Insulation: Install insulation from an estimated existing R-______ to an estimated R-______ approximately ______ sq. ft.

 Floor Insulation: Install insulation from an estimated existing R-______ to an estimated R-_______ approximately _______ sq. ft.

The cost of the installation described above, for which Homeowners will ultimately be responsible under this agreement, is \$ 4132.50

Pacific shall contract with an independent insulation and weatherization contractor and will pay for work done as described above.

Pacific warrants that the insulation and weatherization materials will be installed in a workmanlike manner consistent with prevailing industry standards. If installation is not installed in a workmanlike manner, Pacific, at no expense to the Homeowners, will cause any deficiencies to be

COTTRETED.

If upon completion of installation, Homeowners believe the work is deficient, Homeowners must contact the Manager, Weatherization Services Department, Pacific Power & Light Company, Public Building, 920 S.W. Sixth Avenue, Portland, Oregon 97204, 15030 243-1122, or the District Manager at their local Pacific Power & Light Company district office.

EXCEPT FOR THE WARRANTIES EXPRESSLY DESCRIBED IN THIS AGREEMENT, PACIFIC MAKES NO OTHER HOMEOWNERS, WILL START UPON COMPLETION OF THE INSTALLATION OF THE INSTALLATION, AND LIMITED TO THE 90-DAYS FROM THAT DATE, HOMEOWNERS' REMEDIES FOR ANY CLAIM, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO EXPRESS PRESSLY DESCRIBED HEREIN, AND IN NO EVENT SHALL PACIFIC BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES TO HOMEOWNERS OR ANYONE ELSE.

Pacific conducts Home Energy Analyses at the request of its customers to determine the cost-effectiveness of insulation and weatherization based upon average consumption partierns and typical local weather conditions. However, because of the variability and uniqueness of individual energy faith concerning the anticipated benefits of insulation and weatherization and weatherization in good the insulation and weatherization materials provided for in this agreement will result in savings of money or electrical consumption.

4. HOMEOWNERS' OBLIGATION TO REPAY

5. HOMEOWNERS OBLIGATION TO NOTIFY

Homeowners shall notify Pacific in writing of the sale or transfer for consideration of any legal or equitable interest in any part of the property.  (3) the date on which any action or suit is filed to foreclose or recover on the property or any part thereof or any mortgage, lien, judgment or other encumbrance on the property or any part thereof which existed prior to the recording date of this agreement.

.. FERFECTION OF SECURITY INTEREST.

Pacific may record this agreement in the county real property records, and Homeowners shall execute any other documents deemed necessary by Pacific to perfect this security interest.

- 8. Each Homeowner who signs this agreement shall be individually and jointly responsible for performing the obligations of Homeowners in this agreement shall be binding upon the successors and assigns of the parties. Homeowners shall not assign this agreement without the parties.
