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6 THIS MATTER having come on for hearing upon the applica-7 tion of William Rajnus for a zone change from AF (Agricultural 8 Forestry) to A (Agricultural), by the Klamath County Planning 9 Commission, on real property described as a portion of Tax Lot 10 182, Section 16, Township 41, Range 12, Klamath County, Oregon. 11 Public hearings having been heard by the Klamath County Planning 12 Commission on February 26, 1980, wherefrom the testimony, reports, 13 and information produced at the hearing by the applicant, members 14 of the Planning Department Staff and other persons in attendance, 15 the Planning Commission recommended approval to the Board of 16 County Commissioners. Following action by the Planning Commission 17 a public hearing before the Board of County Commissioners was 18 regularly held on March 27, 1980, wherefrom the testimony at 19 said hearing it appeared that the record below was accurate and 20 complete and it appeared from the testimony, reports and exhibits 21 introduced at the hearing before the Planning Commission that the $\mathbf{22}$ application for a change of zone for the subject property, should 23be granted. $\mathbf{24}$ The Board of County Commissioners makes the following

25 Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law as required by Ordinance
26 No. 17, the Klamath County Zoning Ordinance:

- FINDINGS OF FACT FOR ZONE CHANGE:
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1. The Board of County Commissioners found the site to

be located south of the Merrill-Malin Highway, about 1/4 mile west of Malin.

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2. The Board of County Commissioners found the site to 3 be about 4.75 acres in size and rectangular in shape. 4 3. The Board of County Commissioners found that the $\mathbf{5}$ purpose of the zone change is to allow the separation of the 6 homestead from the farmland and that the use of the property 7 would remain the same.

4. The Board of County Commissioners found that proper 9 notification was sent to surrounding property owners, concerned 10 agencies, the local media, and the Malin Area Committee, comply-11 ing with L. C. D. C. Goal No. 1. 12

5. The Board of County Commissioners found that existing 13 and proposed use of the site conforms to the Agricultural Compre-14 hensive Land Use Plan designation, complying with L. C. D. C. 15 16 Goal No. 2.

6. The Board of County Commissioners found that the 17 present and proposed use of the property is agricultural, there-18 fore addressing L. C. D. C. Goal No. 3. 19

7. The Board of County Commissioners found that the site 20is adequately served by utilities and other public facilities, 21 therefore addressing L. C. D. C. Goal No. 11. 22

8. The Board of County Commissioners found site fronts 23 on a paved highway and has adequate access to Malin and other $\mathbf{24}$ areas of the county, therefore addressing L. C. D. C. Goal No. 12. 25

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW FOR ZONE CHANGE:

1. The property affected by the change of zone is 27 adequate in size and shape to facilitate those uses normally 28ZC 80-3 Page -2-

allowed in conjunction with such zoning. ×. . . 1 2 2. The property affected by the proposed change of zone is properly related to streets and highways to adequately 3 serve the type of traffic generated by such uses that may be 4 5 permitted therein. 6 3. The proposed change of zone will have no adverse 7 effect or only limited adverse effect on any property or the 8 permitted uses thereof within the affected area. 9 4. The proposed change of zone is in keeping with land 10 uses and improvements, trends in land development, density of 11 land development and prospective needs for development in the 12 affected area. 13 5. The proposed change of zone is in keeping with any land use plans duly adopted and does in effect represent the 14 highest, best and most appropriate use of the land affected. 15 16 NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered that the application for the zone change from AF (Agricultural Forestry) to A 17 (Agricultural) for William Rajnus on the subject property is 18 19 hereby granted.
