FINDINGS OF FACT AND ORDER

submitted at the hearing, the Hearings Officer made the following Findings of Fact:

## FINDINGS OF FACT:

- 1. The site is adequate in size and shape to house the proposed activity and fits in with the neighborhood as is shown by the fact that there are other mobile homes in the immediate area.
- 2. The site has adequate access to the streets and high-ways to carry the traffic flow generated by the proposed use.
- 3. There would be no adverse effect on the abutting property owners, nor did anyone testify in objection to the granting of the permit.
- 4. The granting of this permit is consistent with the goals of the L. C. D. C.
- 5. The Conditional Use Permit is approved subject to the following conditions:

## CONDITIONS:

- l. Applicant shall remove all existing buildings from said property.
- 2. Applicant shall install a driveway with adequate parking for two vehicles.

The Hearings Officer, based on the foregoing Findings of Fact, accordingly orders as follows:
