Findings of Fact: نيخور والأ FINDINGS OF FACT: 1. The proposed activity does not fit in with the surrounding neighborhood. Although there is a mobile home park (Round Lake Estates) nearby, this mobile home park is situated so that it is much less visable from the public highway. Furthermore, Round Lake Estates does not fit in with the surrounding neighborhood, and further mobile homes in the area would detract from the natural setting of this area. 10 The Hearings Officer, based on the foregoing Findings of 11 Fact, accordingly orders as follows: 12 That real property described as the 13 "parcel of land generally located west of Round Lake Road approximately 3 3/4 miles 14 northwest of Highway No. 66, and more particularly described as that Tract known 15 as Round Lake Estates, being in the SE4 of Section 7, Township 39, Range 8, being Tax 16 Lots 100 through 7700, Klamath County, Oregon" is hereby denied a Conditional Use Permit in accordance with the terms of the Klamath County Zoning Ordinance No. 35, and henceforth will not be allowed placement of mobile homes in the SP-16 (Planned Unit Development) zone.
