DISCHARGE OF BANKRUPT

It appearing that the person whose name is marked on the above list was duly adjudged a bankrupt on a petition filed on the date shown after his name and case number, and that no complaint objecting to his discharge was timely filed [or that a complaint objecting to his discharge was filed and, after due notice and hearing, was not sustained]; it is ordered that

1. The bankrupt whose name is marked on the above list is released from all dischargeable debts.
2. Any judgment heretofore or hereafter obtained in any court other than this court is null and void as a determination of the personal liability of the said bankrupt with respect to any of the following: (a) debts dischargeable under § 17a and b of the Bankruptcy Act; (b) unless heretofore or hereafter determined by order of this court to be nondischargeable, debts alleged to be excepted from discharge under clauses (2) and (4) of § 17a of the Act; (c) unless heretofore or hereafter determined by order of this court to be nondischargeable, debts alleged to be excepted from discharge under clause (3) of § 17a of the Act, except those debts on which there was a pending action on the date when the petition was filed as specified above in which a right to jury trial was asserted and a party has made a timely demand therefor or has submitted to this court a signed statement of intention to make such a demand; (d) debts determined by this court to be discharged under § 17c of the Act.

3. All creditors whose debts are discharged by this order and all creditors whose judgments are declared null and void by paragraph 2 above are enjoined from instituting or continuing any action or employing any process to collect such debts as personal liabilities of the bankrupt whose name is marked on the above list.

Certified copies of the Discharge of Bankrupt may be obtained from the Bankruptcy Judge, or if case is closed, from the Clerk of Court for registration in other districts, at 313 Pioneer Courthouse, Portland, Oregon 97204.
