RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, in the book of Deeds recorded in Volume M80, Page 3263,
CLARENCE T. and MARGUERITE JENNINGS, conveyed to Klamath County, Oregon,
certain property for County road purposes described as follows:

Beginning at the Southeast corner of the N 1/2 N 1/2
NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 11, T. 39 S., R. 9 E., W.M.;
thence West, along the South line of the N 1/2 N 1/2
NW 1/4 SE 1/4, 45.00 feet; thence North, parallel with
the East line of the N 1/2 N 1/2 NW 1/4 SE 1/4 to the
Southerly right-of-way of the U.S.R.S. "A" Canal; thence
Southeasterly, along said right-of-way line to the East
line of the N 1/2 N 1/2, NW 1/4 SE 1/4; thence South,
along said line to the point of beginning. Excepting
therefrom, that part of the above described tract lying
within Homedale Road.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Klamath County, Oregon
sitting in regular session on the 9th day of May, 1980, deemed it to be
in the best interest of said County to accept the above described property
for County road purposes, and

WHEREAS, the property described above is needed for the widening of
Homedale Road.

IT IS THEREFORE HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED, that the above described
property conveyed to Klamath County, Oregon by CLARENCE T. and MARGUERITE
JENNINGS on the 12th day of February, 1980, shall be accepted as County
road right-of-way.
