MEMORANDUM OF MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT

This memorandum made this 8th day of MAY, 19 80, hereby acknowledges that a maintenance and administration agreement was entered into between the State of Oregon, by and through its Department of Transportation, Parks and Recreation Division and Klamath County Museum on April 30, 19 80, with regard to the following described real property:

PARCEL 1

Lot 7, Block 24, Original Town of Linkville, now City of Klamath Falls, Oregon, according to the duly recorded plat thereof, reserving and excepting a strip 12' wide along the southerly line of said lot for right-of-way for ingress and egress to owners and the public serving them of Lots 2 and 3 in said block, and strip to be entirely in Lot 7.

PARCEL 2


Lots 1 and 2 of Block 24 of Linkville plat, City of Klamath Falls, Oregon.

PARCEL 3

The west 1/2 of vacated Cedar Street.


This agreement provides that the State shall act on behalf of Klamath County Museum in obtaining funds from the Heritage Conservation and Recreation Service for the acquisition of or performance of work on the above described property. In consideration of the receipt of \$10,000 from the Heritage Conservation and Recreation Service, Klamath County Museum has agreed to maintain, repair and administer the above described property so as to preserve the historical integrity of the property and to administer the premises in conformance with the Heritage Conservation and Recreation Service policy and procedures, for a period of 5 years.
