- To keep all buildings unceasingly insured during the term of the mortgage, against loss by fire and such other hazards in such company or companies and in such an amount as shall be satisfactory to the mortgagee; to deposit with the mortgagee all such collicies with receipts showing payment in full of all premiums; all such insurance shall be made payable to the mortgagee; insurance shall be kept in force by the mortgagor in case of foreclosure until the period of redemption expires;

Default in any of the covenants or agreements herein contained or the expenditure of any portion of the loan for purposes shall cause the entire indebtedness at the option of the mortgagee given before the expenditure is made, mortgage subject to foreclosure.

The failure of the mortgagee to exercise any options herein set forth will not constitute a waiver of any right arising from a

In case foreclosure is commenced, the mortgagor shall be liable for the cost of a title search, attorney fees, and all other costs incurred in connection with such foreclosure.

Upon the breach of any covenant of the mortgage, the mortgages shall have the right to enter the premises, take possession, collect the rents, issues and profits and apply same, less reasonable costs of collection, upon the indebtedness and the mortgages shall have the right to the appointment of a receiver to collect same.
