Homeowners may pay such cost to Pacific at any time prior to the time payment is due.

5. HOMEOWNERS OBLIGATION TO NOTIFY

Homeowners shall notify Pacific in writing of the sale or transfer for consideration of any legal or equitable interest in any part of the property. whether it is voluntary or involuntary.
