The Horsefly Irrigation District completed payment of all construction charges pursuant to its repayment contract in 1978. You requested that I determine that a general pattern of family size ownerships has been established and exempt the district from the acreage limitation provisions of Reclamation law based on Solicitor's Opinion M36634, 68 I.D. 372, 405 (1961).

The Department has carefully reviewed the factual information with regard to ownership holdings in the Horsefly Irrigation District. My Solicitor has advised me that in order to meet the requisite standard, it is not necessary to find that all parcels are now held in ownerships of 160 acres or less. Instead, I must determine whether, in general, the breakup of excess acreage as required by the Reclamation law into family size ownerships has been achieved.

The evidence indicates that all ownerships in your district are approximately 160 acres or less (320 acres for husband and wife). The land in farm enterprises in your district appears to be family businesses as is evidenced by the number of family members involved in each. The landowners in the district also took appropriate action to bring the land into full compliance with Reclamation law in accordance with contract payout provisions in effect in the early 1950's. These efforts represented a good faith on their part to come into compliance with the procedures in effect. at that time.

Consequently, I conclude that a general pattern of family consequently, i conclude that a general pattern of family sized ownerships has been established. The lands included in the Horsefly Irrigation District on the date of this letter are exempt from the acreage limitation and residency provisions of the 1902 Reclamation Act.
