Klamath County Planning FINDINGS OF FACT AND ORDER

1. The site for the proposed use is adequate in size and shape to accommodate said use and that all yards, spaces, walls, and fences, parking, loading, landscaping and other features required to adjust said use with the land and use in the neighborhood are present and will be adequately provided.

- 2. The site for the proposed use has adequate access to streets and highways which are adequate in width and pavement type to carry the quantity and kind of traffic generated by the proposed use.
- 3. The proposed use will have no adverse effect on abutting property owners.
- 4. The granting of this Conditional Use Permit is consistent with the L. C. D. C. Goals and Guidelines as set forth in the Staff Report, Klamath County Exhibit A.
- 5. This Conditional Use Permit is approved subject to the following conditions.

CONDITIONS:

- 1. Applicant shall abide by the plot plan entered into evidence as Applicant's Exhibit No. 1.
- 2. The proposed mobile home shall be a double-wide mobile home.

The Hearings Officer, based on the foregoing Findings of Fact, accordingly orders as follows:

That real property described as the

"parcel of land approximately 10,763 square feet in size zoned RD 10,000 (Single Family Residential) generally located east of Dayton Street about 250' south of Boardman Avenue, and more particularly described as being in the N½ of Lot 26, Townsend Tracts, located in the SE¼ SE¾ of Section 3, Township 39, Range 9,
