This is to certify that the following described property

has been evaluated on 8-15-80 and found to be approvable for the installation of one subsurface sewage disposal system in accordance with ORS 454.605 through 454.755 and administrative rules of the Environmental Quality Commission promulgated thereunder.

This approval is given on the basis that the lot or parcel described above will not be further partitioned or subdivided and that conditions on subject or adjacent properties have not been altered in any manner which would prohibit issuance of a permit under the statutes and rules noted above. Any such subdivision, partitioning or alteration voids this certificate.

The subsurface sewage disposal system is to be located on the above-described property as follows:

1. Test holes examined on 8-15-80 revealed loamy sand.
2. A restrictive layer is 36 inches from the ground surface.
3. Minimum drainfield and replacement area setbacks are 100 feet from all wells, and 10 feet from property lines.
4. An equal-sized area for drainfield replacement must be reserved on the property and be kept free from development.
5. A plot plan must be submitted before a construction permit will be issued.
6. Drainfield trenches are not to exceed 24 inches in depth because of the rapidly draining soil conditions.
7. This drainfield must be an equal distribution (see attached).
8. 180 lineal feet of drainfield line is required.
9. A 1000-gallon septic tank should be used for this system.
10. Persons other than the property owner must be licensed to install the system.
11. Please provide your installer with a copy of this letter.
12. You must call this office to inspect the system before covering. The septic tank should be pumped before filling with solids (approximately four years).

A system to be located anywhere on the lot or parcel other than as described above will require an additional site evaluation along with an additional fee.

This certification is valid until a subsurface sewage disposal system is installed pursuant to a permit obtained from Klamath Falls Branch or until earlier cancellation, pursuant to Commission rules, with written notice thereof by the Department of Environmental Quality to the then owners according to Department records or the county tax records, whichever are more current. Subject to the foregoing, this certification runs with the land and will automatically benefit subsequent owners of the land.
