12. Upon default by grantor in payment of any indebtedness secured hereby or in his performance of any afterment hereunder, the beneficiary may declare all sums secured hereby immediately due and payable. 13. Should the beneficiary elect to foreclose by advertisement and sale then after default at any time prior to live days before the date set by the trustee of the trustee's sale, the fantor or other person so privileged by ORS 86.760, may pay to the beneficiary or his successors in interest, respectively, the entire amount then under the terms of the trust deed and the obligation secured thereby (including costs and expenses actually incurred in enforcing the terms of the obligation and trustee's and attorney's lees not exceeding the amounts provided by law) other than such portion of the principal as would not then be due had no default occurred, and thereby cure the default, in which event all foreclosure proceedings shall be dismissed by the trustee.

14. Otherwise, the sale shall be held on the date and at the time and place designated in the notice of sale or the time to which said sale may be postponed as provided by law.
