O R D E R

THIS MATTER having come on for hearing upon the application of Walter Remstedt for a Conditional Use Permit numbered 80-20 to allow condominiums in the SP-16 zone (Planned Unit Development)) by the Klamath County Planning Commission on real property described as Township 39, Range 9, being northwest southwest of Section 2, Tax Lots 3200, 3500, and 4100. Public hearings having been held July 29, 1980, wherefrom the testimony, reports, and information produced at the hearing by the applicant, members of the Planning Department Staff and other persons in attendance, the Planning Commission approved Conditional Use Permit 80-20 for condominiums in a SP-16 zone Planned Unit Development.

The Planning Commission makes the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law as required by Ordinance 17.

## FINDINGS OF FACT:

- 1. The Planning Commission found site for Conditional
  Use Permit was generally located 500' south of South Sixth Street
  and in between Fargo and Gettle Streets of the South Suburban
  Area.
- 2. The Planning Commission found site to be rectangular in shape and development already being there. Size of site approximately 3.6 acres in size.
- 3. The Planning Commission found site to be in an area CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT 80-20, Page One.

where use is close to commercial uses as well as public facilities being a fire station.

- 4. The Planning Commission found site, being already there would not have an adverse affect on surrounding properties.
- 5. The Planning Commission found site had existing access off of Cannon Avenue and sufficient parking to accomodate said use.
- 6. The Planning Commission found site for Conditional Use Permit met Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law from the motions of the Comprehensive Land Use Plan and Zone Change numbered 80-32.

## CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

- 1. The site for the proposed use is adequate in size and shape to accommodate said use and all yards, spaces, walls and fences, parking, loading, landscaping and other features required to adjust said use with land and uses in the neighborhood.
- 2. The site for the proposed use relates to streets and highways adequate in width and pavement type to carry the quantity and kind of traffic generated by the proposed use.
- 3. The proposed use will have no adverse effect on abutting property or the permitted use thereof.
- 4. The conditions stated in the decision are deemed necessary to protect the public health, safety and general welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered that the application for Conditional Use Permit 80-20 for condominiums in the SP-16
