KLAMATH COUNTY PLANNING FINDINGS OF FACT AND ORDER

A hearing was held in this matter at Klamath Falls, Oregon, on September 10, 1980, pursuant to notice given in conformity with Ordinance No. 35, Klamath County, before the Klamath County Hearings Officer, Jim Spindor. The applicant was present. The Klamath County Planning Department was represented by Jonathan Chudnoff. The Hearings Reporter was Barbara Thomson.

Evidence was presented on behalf of the Department and on behalf of the applicant. There were no adjacent property owners present who stated they had objections to the proposed Conditional Use Permit requested by the applicant. one adjacent property owner present who stated she was in favor of the Conditional Use Permit requested by the applicant.

submitted at the hearing, the Hearings Officer made the following Findings of Fact:

FINDINGS OF FACT:

- The site is adequate in size and shape to house the the proposed activity and fits in with the neighborhood so long as the conditions imposed hereinbelow are followed.
- The site has adequate access to streets and highways 2. to carry the traffic flow which would be generated by the proposed use.
- There would be no adverse effect on the abutting 3. property owners, nor did anyone testify in objection to the granting of this permit.
- The granting of this permit is consistent with the goals of the L. C. D. C.
- 5. This Conditional Use Permit is granted subject to the following conditions:

CONDITIONS:

- 1. Any sign advertising applicant's business shall fit in with the neighborhood as near as possible, and shall not be placed on applicant's property without prior approval of the Planning Department.
- Applicant shall provide adequate parking on his 2. property for all vehicles which come to his residence.

The Hearings Officer, based on the foregoing Findings of Fact, accordingly orders as follows:

That real property described as the

"parcel of land approximately 7,500 square feet in size, generally located on the east side of Diamond Street approximately 300 feet

south of Highway No. 66, being in the Stewart Lennox area, and more particularly described as being in the NE4 SW4 of Section 7, Township 1 39, Range 9, being Tax Lot 8300, Klamath County, 2 Oregon" is herby granted a Conditional Use Permit in accordance with the 3 terms of the Klamath County Zoning Ordinance No. 35, and, hence-4 forth will be allowed a ceramic shop in the RD 7,000 (Single 5 6 Family Residential) zone.
