1. The site is adequate in size and shape to house the proposed activity and fits in with the neighborhood as is shown by the fact that there are other mobile homes in the vicinity.

- 2. The site has adequate access to streets and highways to carry the traffic flow which will be generated by the proposed use.
- 3. There would be no adverse effect on the abutting property owners, nor did anyone testify in objection to the granting of this permit.
- 4. The granting of this permit is consistent with the goals of the L. C. D. C.
- 5. The Conditional Use Permit is granted subject to the following conditions:

CONDITIONS:

- 1. Applicant shall follow the plot plan submitted to the Planning Department, Applicant's Exhibit No. 1.
- 2. Applicant shall obtain approval from the Department of Environmental Quality with regard to a septic tank prior to placing the mobile home on the lot.

The Hearings Officer, based on the foregoing Findings of Fact, accordingly orders as follows:
