And it is understood and agreed between said parties that time is of the essence of this contract, and in case the buyer shall fail to make the payments above required, or any of them, punctually within 20 days of the time limited therefor, or fail to keep any agreement herein contained, then the seller at his option shall have the following rights: (1) to declare this contract null and void, (2) to declare the whole unpaid principal balance of said purchase price with the interest thereon at once due and payable, (3) to withdraw said deed and other documents from escribe and/or (4) to forcher the contract by suit in equity, and in any of such cases, all rights and interest created or then existing in favor of the buyer as against the seller hereunder shall utterly case and determine and the right to the possession of the premises above described and all other rights acquired by the buyer hereunder shall revert to and revert in said seller without any act of re-entry, or any other act of said seller to be performed and without any right of the buyer or return, reclumation or compensation for moneys paid on account of the purchase of said property as absolutely, fully and perfectly as if this contract and such payments had never been made; and in case of such default all payments therefolore made on this contract are to be retained by and belong to said seller as the agreed and reasonable rent of said premises up to the time of such default. And the said seller, in case of such default, shall have the right immediately, or at any time thereafter, to enter upon the land aloresaid, without any process of law, and take immediate possession thereof, together with all the improvements and appurtenances thereon or thereto belonging. the land aloresaid, without any process of the final time times and time to require performance by the buyer of any provision hereof shall in no way affect his right hereunder to enforce the same, nor shall any waiver by said seller of any breach of any provision hereof be held to be a waiver of any succeeding breach of any such provision, or as a waiver of the provision itself. The Buyer will supply the Seller a Quitclaim Deed on the property covered by this Contract. Said Quitclaim Deed is to be held by the Seller until the Balance due on this contract is paid off. At that time the Quitclaim Deed is to be returned to the Buyer. Nowever, in case ofdefault by the buyer, the Seller may record the above mentioned Guitclaim Dee. The true and actual consideration paid for this transfer, stated in terms of dollars, is \$ 24,000.00. However, the actual consideration consists of or includes other property or value given or promised which is part of the whole consideration (indicate which). In case suit or action is instituted to foreclose this contract or to enforce any provision hereof, the losing party in said suit or action agrees to pay such sum as the trial court may adjudge reasonable as attorney's less to be allowed the prevailing party in said suit or action agrees to pay such sum as the trial court find court, the losing party further promises to pay such sum as the appellate court shall adjudge reasonable as the prevailing party's attorney's less on such appeal.

In construing this contract, it is understood that the seller or the buyer may be more than one person or a corporation; that if the contest so requires, the singular pronoun shall be taken to mean and include the plural, the masculine, the leminine and the neuter, and that generally all grammatical changes shall be made, assumed and implied to make the provisions hereof apply qually to corporations and to individuals.

This agreement shall bind and inure to the benefit of, as the circumstances may require, not only the immediate parties hereto but their respective heirs, executors, administrators, personal representatives, successors in interest and assigns as well.
