An administrative exemption from acreage limitation provisions of Reclamation Law has been granted for lands which you own that are covered by water service contract 175r-4366. This exemption is based on the fact that payment of all construction charged under the contract 175r-4366 have been completed and that a general pattern of family-size ownership has been established based on Solicitor's Opinion M-36634, 68 I.D. 372, 405 (1961).

The Secretary of the Interior has carefully reviewed factual information regarding your contract and ownership, and has determined that the 117.5 acres owned by you and served under this contract are well within the acreage limitation provisions of law and appear to be a part of a family-farm operation.

Consequently, the Secretary concluded that the 117.5 acres served under contract 175r-4366 in the Klamath Project, Oregon-California, are exempt from the acreage limitation and residency provisions of the 1902 Reclamation Act.
