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This particular part of the applicant's property is very steep, rocky, and cannot be used for agricultural purposes.

7. The site for the proposed use has adequate access to streets and highways which are adequate in width and pavement to carry the quantity and kind of traffic generated by the propos= ed use.

The proposed use will have no adverse effect on abutting property or the permitted use thereof.

9. The granting of this Conditional Use Permit is Consistent with the L. C. D. C. Goals and Guidelines.
