This matter coming before the Court on this 17 day of August, 1970, and the Plaintiff appearing in person and by and through her attorney, Ronald M. Somers, and the Defendant appearing not and an Order of Default having been duly taken against the said Defendant and having given testimony as to the allegations in Plaintiff's Complaint and the Court having found those matters contained in Plaintiff's Complaint to be true and that the Defendant is in the military service of the United States and did consent to the above entitled Court to enter a Decree against him, and that the District Attorney has been served with a copy of the Summons and Complaint and entered his Waiver of Appearance on the 17 day of August, 1970, and that an Order has been entered waiving the 90-day waiting period, and the Court being fully advised in the premises,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that an absolute decree of divorce is granted to the Plaintiff herein, and the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Plaintiff and the Defendant are dissolved and forever held a nullity.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Plaintiff is awarded the care, custody and control of the minor children of the parties, namely: Jay Merton Stein, born October 10, 1964 and Jennie Lee Stein, born May 5, 1968, subject to the reasonable visitation rights of the Defendant herein after reasonable notice has been given to the Plaintiff.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Defendant

1 is to pay to the Plaintiff the sum of \$100 per month per child  
2 until each of the minor children reaches the age of majority or  
3 sooner becomes emancipated. The first of said support payments  
4 shall commence on the 1st day of September, 1970, with like  
5 payments coming due on the same day of each month thereafter.

6 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Plaintiff  
7 is awarded as her sole and separate property, free from any  
8 interest of the Defendant therein, the 1967 Pontiac Stationwagon,  
9 the household furniture and furnishings and her personal effects.

10 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Defendant  
11 is awarded as his sole and separate property, free from any  
12 interest of the Plaintiff therein the stereo, hunting equipment,  
13 cameras and his personal effects.

14 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Defendant  
15 is to maintain an insurance program for the two minor children of  
16 the parties.

17 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Defendant  
18 is to pay the attorney fees for the Plaintiff in the sum of \$350,  
19 together with the costs and disbursements incurred herein.

20 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the marriage  
21 of the parties shall terminate on the 17th day of Oct.,  
22 1970, or, if appeal is taken, then upon determination on appeal,  
23 whichever is later, without further action of either party.

24 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that if either  
25 party shall die before said date, the marriage shall terminate  
26 immediately before such death, unless an appeal is pending; upon  
27 such death, (if an appeal is pending) the estate of decedent shall  
28 be the nominal party, and the Supreme Court shall have the power  
29 to determine finally all matters presented on such appeal.

30 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that any Will  
31 of either party antedating the date hereof is revoked, unless  
32 its terms express a contrary intention.



IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that neither party is entitled to cohabit with the other from the date hereof.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that this Decree may be vacated within sixty (60) days from this date or during an appeal, upon joint motion of the parties.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Property Settlement Agreement between the Plaintiff and Defendant entered into the records of this Court be and hereby is approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Defendant is to pay to the Plaintiff the sum of \$150 per month for the support of the Plaintiff for a period of 90 days from the commencement of this suit.
