3. LIMITED WARRANTY PROVISION

Pacific shall contract with an independent insulation and weatherization contractor and will pay for work done as described above.

Edulic warrants that the insulation and weatherization materials will be installed in a workmanlike manner consistent with prevailing industry corrected.

It installation is not installed in a workmanlike manner, Pacific, at no expense to the Homeowners, will cause any deficiencies to be

Corrected.

All upon completion of installation, Homeowners believe the work is deficient, Homeowners must contact the Manager, Weatherization Services Department, Pacific Power & Light Company, Public Building, 920 S.W. Sixth Avenue, Portland, Oregon 97204, (503) 243-1122, or the District Manager at their local Pacific Power & Light Company district office.

EXCEPT FOR THE WARRANTIES EXPRESSLY DESCRIBED IN THIS AGREEMENT, PACIFIC MAKES NO OTHER WARRANTIES, ALL EXPRESS AND IMPLIED WARRANTIES ARE EXTENDED ONLY TO AND LIMITED TO THE HOMEOWNERS, WILL START UPON COMPLETION OF THE INSTALLATION OF THE INSULATION, AND LIMITED TO THE OR IMPLIED WARRANTIES, NEGLIGENCE, STRICT LIABILITY OR CONTRACT ARE LIMITED TO THOSE REMEDIES FOR ANY CLAIM; INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO EXPRESS SEQUENTIAL DAMAGES TO HOMEOWNERS OR ANYONE ELSE.

Individual Homeowners (natural persons) shall pay to Pacific, without interest, the actual contract cost of the insulation and weatherization prior to the sale or transfer for consideration of any legal or equitable interest in any part of the property.
