HOMEOWNERS' REMEDIES FOR ANY CLAIM, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO EXPRESS OR IMPLIED WARRANTIES, NEGLIGENCE, STRICT LIABILITY OR CONTRACT ARE LIMITED TO THOSE REMEDIES EX OR IMPLIED WARRANTIES, NEGLIGENCE, STRICT LIABILITY OR CONTRACT ARE LIMITED TO THOSE REMEDIES EX-PRESSLY DESCRIBED HEREIN, AND IN NO EVENT SHALL PACIFIC BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY INCIDENTAL OR CON-SEQUENTIAL DAMAGES TO HOMEOWNERS OR ANYONE ELSE.

However, because of the variability and uniqueness of individual energy e, it is not possible to precisely predict the savings that will accrue to any particular individual. Therefore, Pacific, by providing information in good faith concerning the anticipated benefits of insulation and weatherization, or by entering into this agreement, does not warrant that the installation of the insulation and weatherization materials provided for in this agreement will result in savings of money or electrical consumption.

## 4. HOMEOWNERS, OBLIGATION TO REPAY

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Individual Homeowners (natural persons) shall pay to Pacific, without interest, the actual contract cost of the insulation and weatherization prior to the sale or transfer for consideration of any legal or equitable interest in any part of the property. Homeowners other than natural persons topporations, trusts, etc.) shall pay to Pacific, without interest, the actual contract cost of the insulation and weatherization within seven years of the date of this agreement. Homeowners may pay such cost to Pacific at any time prior to the time payment is due.

### 5. HOMEOWNERS' OBLIGATION TO NOTIFY

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Homeowners shall notify Pacific in writing of the sale or transfer for consideration of any legsl or equitable interest in any part of the property. whether it is voluntary or involuntary. Such notice shall be sent as soon as Homeowners know that there will be a sale or transfer for considera-tion, and not later than one week before the expected sale or transfer. The notice must include the name of the Homeowners, the address of the property; the name of the person to whom the property is being sold or transferred; and the name of any person or company who is acting as a closing agent for the sale or transfer or is otherwise participating in the transaction. Homeowners authorized Pacific to contact any of the persons ed and authorize and direct such persons to pay Pacific any obligations owing under this agreement from any monies which such persons so nam owe to Homeowners.
