1. RECITALS

- 1. In order to ensure the integrity of the General Plan and Restrictions, the Architectural Committee imposes the following conditions on the approval of Use Permit No. 1-81.
 - (a) Lot 33 Block 24 shall not be sold or transferred without first removing said barn.
 - (b) or, that the transferee erect a house or mobil home, upon said lot 33 upon the close of escrow.
 - (c) or, if both lots 33 and 34 are transferred then the conditional use permit inures to said transferee.
 - (d) or, if the Architectural Committee receives a substantial number of complaints from other lot owners, then upon demand the owner of said lots 33 and 34 shall merge the title to said lots.
