12. Upon default by grantor in payment of any indebtedness secured hereby or in his performance of any agreement hereunder, the beneficiary may declare all sums secured hereby immediately due and payable. In such an event the beneficiary at his election may proceed to forecome this trust deed in equity as a mortfage or direct the trustee to foreclose this first deed by advertisement and sale. In the latter event the beneficiary or the trustee shall execute and cause to be recorded his written notice of default and selection to sell the said described real property to satisfy the obligations secured hereby, whereupon the trustee shall lix the time and place of sale, give notice thereof as then required by law and proceed to foreclose this trust deed in the manner provided in ORS 86.740 to 86.795.

13. Should the beneficiary elect to foreclose by advertisement and sale then after default at any time prior to live days before the date set by the trustee for the trustee's sale, the grantor or other person so privileged by ORS 86.760, may pay to the beneficiary or his successors in interest, respectively, the entire amount then due under the terms of the trust deed and the obligation secured thereby (including costs and expenses actually incurred ending the terms of the obligation costs and trustee's and attorney's lees not exceeding the amounts provided by law) other than such portion of the principal as would not then be due had no default occurred, and thereby cure the default, in which event all foreclosure proceedings shall be dismissed by the trustee.

Trustee is not obligated to notily any party hereto of pending sale under any other deed of trust or of any action or proceeding in which grantor, beneficiary or trustee shall be a party unless such action or proceeding is brought by trustee.
