4. HOMEOWNERS' OBLIGATION TO REPAY

Individual Homeowners (natural persons) shall pay to Pacific, without interest, the actual contract cost of the insulation and weatherization prior to the sale or transfer for consideration of any legal or equitable interest in any part of the property. Homeowners other than natural persons prior to the sale or transfer for consideration of any legal or equitable interest in any part of the property. Homeowners other than natural persons transfer for consideration of any legal or equitable interest in any part of the property. prior to the sale of transfer for computation of any logar of equipment and any part of the property. Itomeowners other train natural persons (corporations, trusts, etc.) shall pay to Pacific, without interest; the actual contract cost of the insulation and weatherization within seven years of the date of this agreement. Homeowners may pay such cost to Pacific at any time prior to the time payment is due.

5. HOMEOWNERS' OBLIGATION TO NOTIFY

Homeowners shall notify Pacific in writing of the sale or transfer for consideration of any legal or equitable interest in any part of the property. romeowners shau noting racine in writing or the sale or transfer for consideration of any legal of equality interests that of parts of the respective for consideration, and not later than one week before the expected sale or transfer. The notice must include the name of the Homeowners, the address of the property, the name of the person to whom the property is being sold or transferred, and the name of any person or company who is acting as a property, the name of the person to whom the property is being sont of transaction. Homeowners authorized Pacific to contact any of the persons closing agent for the sale or transfer or is otherwise participating in the transaction. Homeowners authorized Pacific to contact any of the persons so named and authorize and direct such persons to pay Pacific any obligations owing under this agreement from any monies which such persons owe to Homeowners.

To secure the Homeowners' obligations herein. Homeowners hereby mortgage to Pacific the property, together with all present and future appurtenances, improvements, and fixtures thereto. This paragraph shall not take effect until that date which is one day prior to the earliest to occur appurtenances, improvements, and fixtures thereto.

(1) Pacific in good faith makes a substantial beginning of performance of the contract before you give notice of cancellation; and 11) Factify in good faith makes a substantial neginning of performance of the contract perfore you give notice of cancellation; and
(2) In the case of goods, the goods cannot be returned to Pacific in substantially as good condition as when received by Homeowners.

HOMEOWNER'S RIGHT TO CANCEL. (FEDERAL STATUTE). You, the Homeowner, may cancel this transaction at any time prior to midnight of the third business day after the date of this transaction. See the attached notice of cancellation form for an explanation of this right.
