FINDENGS OF FACT:

- 1. The site is adequate in size and shape to house the proposed activity and will fit in with the surrounding neighborhood so long as the conditions set forth hereinbelow are followed.
- 2. The site has adequate access to streets and high-ways to carry the traffic flow generated by the proposed use.
- 3. There would be no adverse effect on the abutting property owners, nor did anyone testify in objection to the granting of this permit.
