ORDINANCE NO. 6144

Original

AN ORDINANCE VACATING THAT DEDICATED ALLEY LYING IN THE SOUTHERLY PORTION OF BLOCK 6 OF THE HOT SPRINGS SECOND ADDITION IN THE CITY OF KLAMATH FALLS, OREGON.

WHEREAS, on September 19, 1977, pursuant to Resolution No. 2523, the Common Council of the City of Klamath Falls, Oregon, held a public hearing on a proposal to vacate that dedicated alley lying in the southerly portion of Block 6 of the Hot Springs Second Addition in the City of Klamath Falls, Oregon; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council received a recommendation from the Planning Commission, which conducted a public hearing on August 8, 1977, which recommended approval of the proposed vacation; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Klamath Falls has determined that it is in the best interest of the City that said alley be vacated; therefore,

THE CITY OF KLAMATH FALLS ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1.

That dedicated alley lying in the southerly portion of Block 6 of the Hot Springs Second Addition be vacated.

Section 2.

A sum of \$2,200 shall be paid to the City, by the property owner adjacent to the vacated rights-of-way, in satisfaction of Section 42 of the City Charter.
