

QUITCLAIM DEED

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PACIFIC POWER & LIGHT COMPANY, a Maine corporation, hereby releases and quitclaims to KLAMATH COUNTY, STATE OF OREGON, a political subdivision, all its right, title and interest arising out of that certain conveyance designated as "Right-of-Way Easement" granted by Alberni Development Co., a partnership, on April 15, 1977, and recorded in Volume M-76, Page 10961, Deed Records of Klamath County, Oregon, insofar only as said right-of-way pertains to the following described property:

Beginning at the Initial Point of Dodds Hollow Estates, a 2" x 36" galvanized iron pipe, from which the Section corner common to Sections 20, 21, 28 and 29, Township 40 South, Range 11 East, Willamette Meridian, bears N. 00°15'04" E., 608.96 feet; thence S. 63°48'38" W., 60.00 feet; thence N. 26°11'22" W., 50.00 feet; thence along the arc of a 230 foot radius curve to the right 118.15 feet; thence N. 80°37'40" E., 61.83 feet; thence S. 5°00'22" W., 8.28 feet; thence along the arc of a 170 foot radius curve to the left 92.56 feet; thence S. 26°11'22" E., 50.00 feet to the point of beginning.

All interests arising out of said instrument affecting other lands therein described shall remain vested in Pacific Power & Light Company, its successors and assigns.
