EXCEPT FOR THE WARRANTIES EXPRESSLY DESCRIBED IN THIS AGREEMENT, PACIFIC MAKES NO OTHER WARRANTIES. Individual Homeowners (natural persons) shall pay to Pacific, without interest, the actual contract cost of the insulation and weatherization prior to the sale or transfer for consideration of any legal or equitable interest in any part of the property. Homeowners other than natural persons form to the sale of training to a concentration of any regarding interest, in any part of the property, trained mere other manufactural persons (corporations, trusts, etc.) shall pay to Pacific, without interest, the actual contract cost of the insulation and weatherization within seven years of the date of this agreement. Homeowners may pay such cost to Pacific at any time prior to the time payment is due.

5 HOMEOWNERS' OBLIGATION TO NOTIFY
