13. Should the beneficiary elect to foreclose by advertisement and sale then after default at any time prior to five days before the date set by the trustee for the trustees sale, the grantor or other pers is so privileged by ORS 86.760, may pay to the beneficiary or his successors in interest, respectively, the entire amount then due under the terms of the trust deed and the obligation secured thereby (including costs and expenses actually incurred in enforcing the amounts provided by law) other than such portion of the principal as would not then be due had no default occurred, and thereby cure the default, in which event all foreclosure proceedings shall be dismissed by the trustee.

14. Otherwise, the sale shall be held on the date and at the time and place designated in the notice of sale or the time to which said sale may be postponed as provided by law.
