To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, the State of Oregon, acting by and through its Department of Transportation, Parks and Recreation Division, being the owner of certain tracts of land situated and included within the limits of the Siuslaw, Deschutes, and Winema National Forests, Oregon, has, under the provisions of the Act approved March 20, 1922 (42 Stat. 465), as amended (16 U.S.C. 485), the Act approved March 23, 1972 (86 Stat. 99; 16 U.S.C. 460z-6, and Sec. 206 of the Act approved October 21, 1976 (90 Stat. 2743, 2756; 43 U.S.C. 1716), reconveyed and relinquished the said tracts to the United States and has, under the provisions of the Act of March 20, 1922, selected in lieu thereof the following described tracts of land:

All the geothermal steam and associated geothermal resources in the following described lands, and to it, or persons authorized by it, the right to prospect for, mine, and remove such deposits, upon compliance with the conditions and subject to the provisions and limitations of the Act of December 24, 1970 (84 Stat. 1566):

2. The stipulation that the following described land hereby granted shall revert to the United States upon a finding by the Secretary of Agriculture that for a period of five consecutive years such land has not been used by the State of Oregon, for park or recreational purposes, or that such land or any part thereof is being devoted to other use:
