Sixth Avenue, Portland, Oregon 97204, (503) 243-1122, or the District Manager at their local Pacific Power & Light Company district office.

This agreement shall be binding upon the successors and assigns of the parties. Homeowners shall not assign this agreement without the written consent of Pacific.
- 9. This document contains the entire agreement between the parties and shall not be modified except by a written instrument signed by the parties.
