The cost of the installation described above, for which Homeowners will ultimately be responsible under this agreement, is \$ 1,702.60

Pacific shall contract with an independent insulation and weatherization contractor and will pay for work done as described above. Pacific warrants that the insulation and weatherization materials will be installed in a workmanlike manner consistent with prevailing industry standards. If installation is not installed in a workmanlike manner, Pacific, at no expense to the Homeowners, will cause any deficiencies to be

If upon completion of installation, Homeowners believe the work is deficient, Homeowners must contact the Manager, Weatherization 11 upon completion of installation, Tromeowners believe the work is deficient, Tromeowners must contact the Annual Services Department, Pacific Power & Light Company, Public Building, 920 S.W. This warranty gives you specific legal rights, and you may also have other rights which vary from state to state.

Pacific conducts Home Energy Analyses at the request of its customers to determine the cost-effectiveness of insulation and weatherization based upon average consumption patterns and typical local weather conditions. However, because of the variability and uniqueness of individual energy use, it is not possible to precisely predict the savings that will accrue to any particular individual. Therefore, Pacific, by providing information in good faith concerning the anticipated benefits of insulation and weatherization, or by entering into this agreement, does not warrant that the installation of the insulation and weatherization materials provided for in this agreement will result in savings of money or electrical consumption.

# 4. HOMEOWNERS OBLIGATION TO REPAY W.O. # 0/020

Individual Homeowners (natural persons) shall pay to Pacific, without interest, the actual contract cost of the insulation and weatherization prior to the sale or transfer for consideration of any legal or equitable interest in any part of the property. Homeowners other than natural persons (corporations, trusts, etc.) shall pay to Pacific, without interest, the actual contract cost of the insulation and weatherization within seven years of the date of this agreement. Homeowners may pay such cost to Pacific at any time prior to the time payment is due.

### 5. HOMEOWNERS' OBLIGATION TO NOTIFY

Homeowners shall notify Pacific in writing of the sale or transfer for consideration of any legal or equitable interest in any part of the property. whether it is voluntary or involuntary. Such notice shall be sent as soon as Homeowners know that there will be a sale or transfer for consideration, and not later than one week before the expected sale or transfer. - 8. Each Homeowner who signs this agreement shall be individually and jointly responsible for performing the obligations of Homeowners in this agreement. This agreement shall be binding upon the successors and assigns of the parties. Homeowners shall not assign this agreement without the
