

EASEMENT FOR SEWER LINES

That We, E. J. CLOUGH and LEROY A. GIENGER, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, and convey to the CITY OF CHILOQUIN, CHILOQUIN, OREGON, a perpetual easement for the installation, replacement, repair of and maintenance of sewer or sewers, power and signal cables, to be installed below the surface of the ground, together with rights of access thereto for the purposes stated, on, in and along the following described parcel of land:

The easterly 12.0 feet of Lot 5, Block 15 First Addition to Chiloquin, Klamath County, Oregon.

Together with the right to ingress and egress over the adjacent lands of the Grantor, his successor and assigns, for the purposes of this easement.

IT IS EXPRESSLY UNDERSTOOD, that this easement does not convey the right, title, or interest to the surface of the soil, but only the reasonable use thereof, for the purposes here and above stated not any other rights except those expressly stated in this easement, or to prevent the Grantors from the full use of the land for purposes not inconsistent with the easement.

The true and actual consideration paid for this transfer stated in terms of dollars is \$316.80.
